Dear all,

We would like to bring your attention to the new arrangements for transfer of postgraduate students within and across the Clear Water Bay (CWB) and Guangzhou (GZ) campuses which were approved by the Joint Deans/DIPO's meeting held on 18 May 2022. In view of the increased enquiries from pilot scheme students on transfer, a standardized procedure and guidelines have been devised as follows. You may also wish to refer to the attached summary on the arrangements.

Transfer within CWB campus

For current $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ cohort GZ pilot scheme students, transfer from the IIP (GZ thrust area) program to non-IIP program within CWB campus with the same prime supervisor is allowed except in the last term of their in-time period. Approval on students' application for change of study program is at the discretion of the "transfer-in" program and the respective Department and School, which should follow the prevailing transfer policy and procedure. Supervisors should be mindful that upon transfer, <u>PGS from GZ central will cease</u>, and there will be <u>no PGS matching from CWB central</u>.

Transfer between CWB and GZ campus

Following the formal establishment of HKUST(GZ), both CWB and GZ students (from 4th cohort onwards) may apply for change of study programs across campuses through <u>admission</u>, <u>with the condition that the prime supervisors of the "new" and "withdrawal" programs cannot be identical</u>. Students are required to withdraw from the existing program before registering to a program in another campus. PGS will continue to be provided according to the prevailing policy of the respective campus. Admission to GZ programs should comply with the related regulations/policy under the Ministry of Education (MoE) in Mainland China.

The above arrangement of supervisor and PGS arrangement will take immediate effect. It will be appreciated if you would disseminate the above to the supervisors and administrative colleagues within your Departments and Thrusts; so that the program transfer applications will be processed according to the above guidelines.

Arrangements for Transfer Across the Campuses

With immediate effect, current students interested in "transferring" to a program offered by another campus, may apply for program transfer or admission according to the following:

1st – 3rd cohort pilot scheme students (admitted at *CWB initially*)



Program Transfer to regular CWB non-IIP program (Not allowed for students in their last term of the in-time period)	
Supervisor arrangement	Same prime supervisor for transfer-in and transfer-out programs allowed
PGS arrangement	 PGS support from GZ will cease No PGS matching from CWB Central

4th cohort onwards GZ students



Apply for admission* as a new student to CWB (E.g. withdraw from PhD(AI) in GZ, and apply for admission to PhD(CSE) in CWB)		
Supervisor arrangement	Prime supervisors of the new and withdrawal programs <u>CANNOT</u> be identical	
PGS arrangement	Student time-limit reset, PGS offer according to the prevailing policy of the respective campus	

^{*}To comply with the related admissions policy under MoE and practices in Mainland China

^{**} CWB students may be transferred to GZ as long as prime supervisors in the GZ campus can be identified. Full PGS has to be provided by the new supervisors.
